Quotations must be enclosed in a properly sealed envelope addressed to the Member Secretary, Departmental Purchase Committee, Department of Forest, Punjab, by designation and not by name. The quotations must be super scribed.

" Quotations for the supply of Feed & Folder during the year 2011-12 at F.O.R. M.C. Zoological Park, Chhatbir, Punjab as called for in tender notice, dated 05.03.2011.

The quotations must reach the Member Secretary, Departmental Purchase Committee, Department of Forest, Punjab by 22.03.2011 of the date mentioned in the tender notice.

The tenderer may be a trader or supplier having VAT number.

In the event of the quotations being submitted by a partner firm it must be signed separately by each member thereof, or in the event of the absence of any partner it must be signed on his behalf by a person holding a power of attorney authorizing him to do so, or in the case of a company the quotations should be executed in the manner laid down in the said company's Articles of Association. The signatures on the quotations should be deemed to be authorized signatures.

All the columns of the quotation form shall be duly, properly and exhaustively filled in. The rates and units shall not be over-written. Quotations shall always be both in the figures and words. The words " No quotations" should be written across any or all of the items in the schedule-A for which a tenderer does not wish to tender.

All corrections must be signed by the tenderers.

Earnest Money deposits mentioned in Section-I of the Tender Document in the form of a Bank draft in favour of the Field Director, M.C. Zoological Park, Chhatbir, Punjab payable at Zirakpur must accompany the tender document, without which it will not be considered. The said amount will be regarded as forfeitable to Government, if any successful tenderer fails within the time fixed by the authority competent to sanction the contract either to sign the contract on terms contained in the invitation for tender, its tender form and quotation form and condition of contract referred to the invitation of tenders

10% of all the payments made will be retained as security which will be released only on successful completion of the contract.

2. As per directions of Central Zoo Authority, New Delhi only those tenderers can participate in the tender for supply of meat who have got the valid license from the concerned Municipal Corporation and the meat must be duly stamped by the authorized Veterinarian of the concerned municipality.

Schedule-B

Terms and conditions for the supply of Feed and Fodder to M.C. Zoological Park, Chhatbir, Punjab.

1. Earnest Money :- Tender should be accompanied with an earnest money deposit of Rs. _____ either in form of demand draft issued by a scheduled bank or Treasury receipt in favour of the Field Director, M.C. Zoological Park, Chhatbir, Punjab. Tenders not accompanied by the earnest money will be rejected. Earnest money is liable to be forfeited to Govt. if the tender fails to comply with any of the stipulated conditions. The earnest money of all the unsuccessful bidders shall be returned immediately after the process of tender is complete. No interest on earnest money will be paid.
2. The successful bidders will be required to deposit security @ 10% of the total estimated value of each estimated item subject to the minimum Rs.10000/- in the form of fixed deposit at the Post Office or Fixed deposit at a scheduled bank duly pledged in favour of the Field Director, M.C. Zoological Park, Chhatbir, Punjab within ten days of the communication of sanction of the contract. In case the contractor fails to deposit the security within stipulated period, he will be liable to pay extra amount of late fees upto Rs.50/- per day at the discretion of the Field Director, M.C. Zoological Park, Chhatbir, Punjab. The offer/sanction is liable to be cancelled in case security is not deposit within twenty days from the date of sanction.
3. The security so deposited by the contractor will only be released on the successful completion of the contract.
4. The period of the contract will be/shall be for one year from **(01.04.2011 to 31.03.2012)**
5. The rates so quoted will be firm and remain the same during the contract of one year. No increase in price of any item shall be allowed under any circumstances during the period of contract.
6. Per unit cost of the material/goods should be quoted inclusive of all taxes (ST,CST,VAT, Octroi etc.) as applicable.
7. The statement showing the estimated quantity of each article required through out the year is enclosed. However, the quantity of the supplies is liable

to be increased or decreased according to the circumstances/requirement for which advance/oral or written notice will be given to the tenderer/contractor.

8. The contractor will be responsible to supply the stock to the Field Director, M.C. Zoological Park, Chhatbir, Punjab personally or through his representative according to the requirement.

9. The supplies will be weighed at the stores immediately on receipt.

10. The contractor will be responsible to obtain a receipt after weighing of supplies from the official deputed to receive the supplies which will be attached with the bills to be submitted by the contractor.

11. For the articles which are required to be supplied daily, the contractor(s) will have to ascertain the requirement at least one day in advance by 4.00 PM from the Incharge M.C. Zoological Park Chhatbir.

12. The supplies will be inspected by the authorized representative or Gazetted Officer of any other Wildlife Officer not below the rank of a Wildlife Inspector and in case of defective/substandard supplies or in case of deliberate non supply the purchase shall be effected by Field Director, M.C. Zoological Park, Chhatbir, Punjab from the open market and any amount so incurred will be recovered from the contractor from his security deposit or as arrear of land revenue till the new contract is finalized.

13. In case of breach of the terms and conditions, the contractor is liable to lose his claim over the security.

14. The supply of fresh articles should be free from dust, infestation of insects, fungi and worms etc. The supplies of dry stores shall also conform to the same standards, which are prescribed for human consumption of such articles by the competent Government authorities.

15. The Departmental Purchase Committee reserves the right to accept or reject the lowest tender without assigning any reason for such acceptance/rejection.

16. In the event of supplies not conforming to good quality. Field Director, M.C. Zoological Park Chhatbir, Punjab may at his sole discretion reject or accept the supplies subject to such reduction in the price as the supplies or the quality of the supplies accepted.

17. The offer shall be valid for acceptance within one month from the date of opening of the tender. The tender once accepted will be valid upto 31.03.2012.

18. The interested parties should inspect the size of supply in their own interest before submitting their tenders.

19. One copy of these terms and conditions duly signed at the place specified by an authorized representative of the firm/supplier must be returned along with the tenders.

20. Conditional tender shall not be accepted.

21. The quotations may be accepted in part or whole.

22. In case of any dispute on the tender the decision of the Department Purchase Committee shall be final and binding.

23. As per direction of Central Zoo Authority, New Delhi only those tenderers can participate in the tender who will supply meat from the abattoir which have valid license from the concerned Municipal Corporation and the meat is duly stamped(certified) by the Veterinarian of the concerned municipality.

This condition will form and will be considered as part of the agreement.

24. The successful bidder will have to execute an agreement after the sanction for acceptance of the offer is given by the competent authority.

25. Income tax as applicable will be deducted from the payments.
